# Elder Board Update...

Wow! What happened to 2021? It seems so long ago with all our recent changes. You may still be processing things as we all are and that's normal. Let me share the heart of the Elders. We are unified in Spirit even though there are various ideas on the Board. We want to be thorough in our process, not rushed, and not dawdling. We want to discover what man God has chosen for us. We want a Pastor of character who can build on the foundation Pastor Marcus has established.

To that end, we are current-

ly looking locally at Corban University, with NAB, and other sources for a possible interim candidate. If unsuccessful locally, we will engage Interim Pastoral Ministries (IPM) in a nationwide recruitment.

We are now in Phase 1 of the process with our Preaching Team and our interim Pastor search. Phase 2 is calling, selecting, and establishing an interim Pastor. Phase 3 will be searching, recruiting, vetting, and hiring a new Senior Pastor. We will use a larger and broader cross section of West Hills folks for Phase 3.

And let me assure you, that because of your generosity, we have plenty of reserve funds to take care of the family moves required and the other incidental costs of the transition. Questions or concerns? Please call or email one of the Elders. Next month we will talk about Interim Pastors and what they are called on to do.

We have three D-groups started already! A D-group is a great opportunity to stay connected in God's Word.


