Luke 7:11-17

In the account of the resurrection of **the widow of Nain's son**, we are reminded of Jesus' power to bring new spiritual life to all who trust in Him.

## 1. Two \_\_\_\_\_ met (vs. 11-13, Heb. 11:10, 13-16, John 3:36, Eph. 2:1-10, John 5:24).

LIFE

> The widow had lost her \_\_\_\_\_ as well as her \_\_\_\_\_.


